Open-Ended Questions

An important element is Open-ended Questions. The teacher creates the appropriate toolbox for each student by utilising the Open-ended Questions. It depends on the topic of each course (Time Management, Storytelling etc.)





Know your audience

It is important to read the audience first and refrain from using the same toolkits for every class.

Technological tools differ depending on the subject of education. The important thing is choosing a technological tool to operate through experience. Recommend a tool if you have used it and know that this will help the students.




TIME MANAGEMENT

CONTINUOUS TRAINING

The most important of all is the continuous training of the teacher, i.e. lifelong learning.





CREATIVITY

An important factor is Creativity. We must find ways to optimise each person's experience. The goal is to motivate students to implement what they've learned outside class.

COMMUNICATICABILITY

Another critical factor is Communication and Communicability.
